

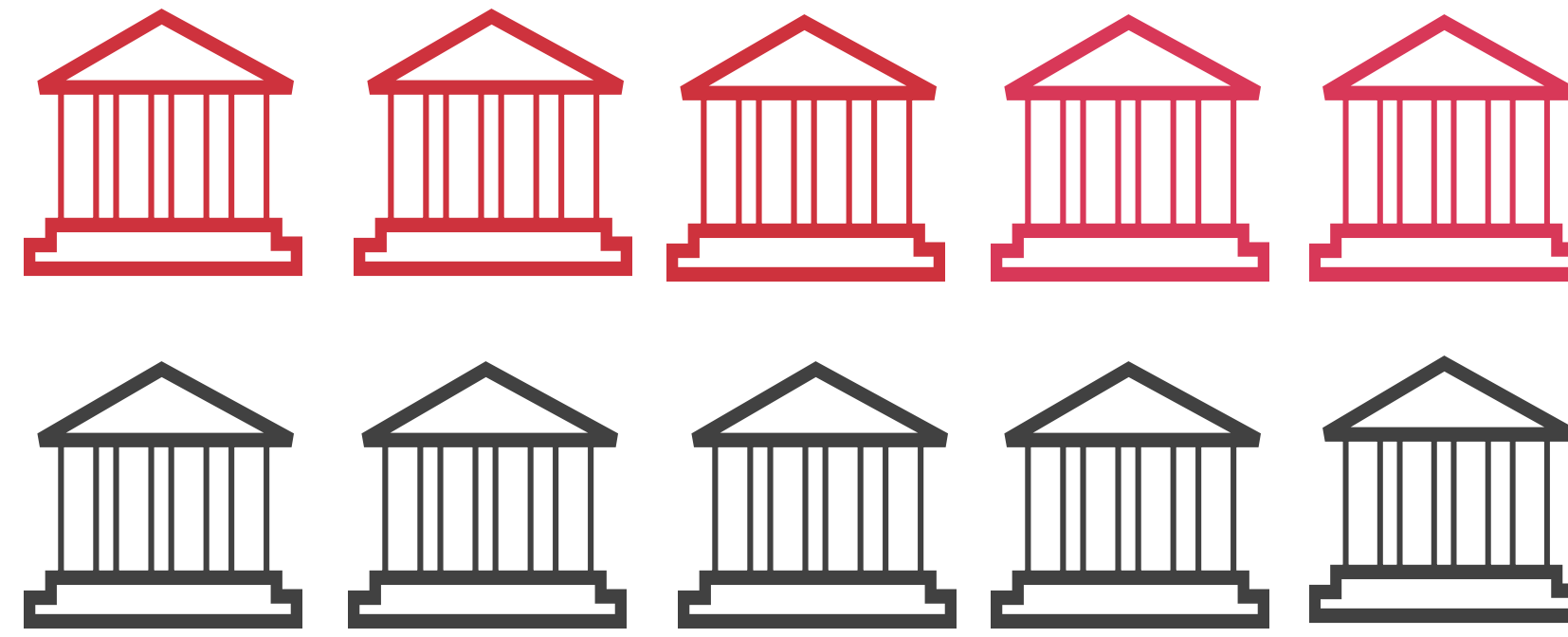
# ALL IN Campus Democracy Challenge

## Maine State Summary

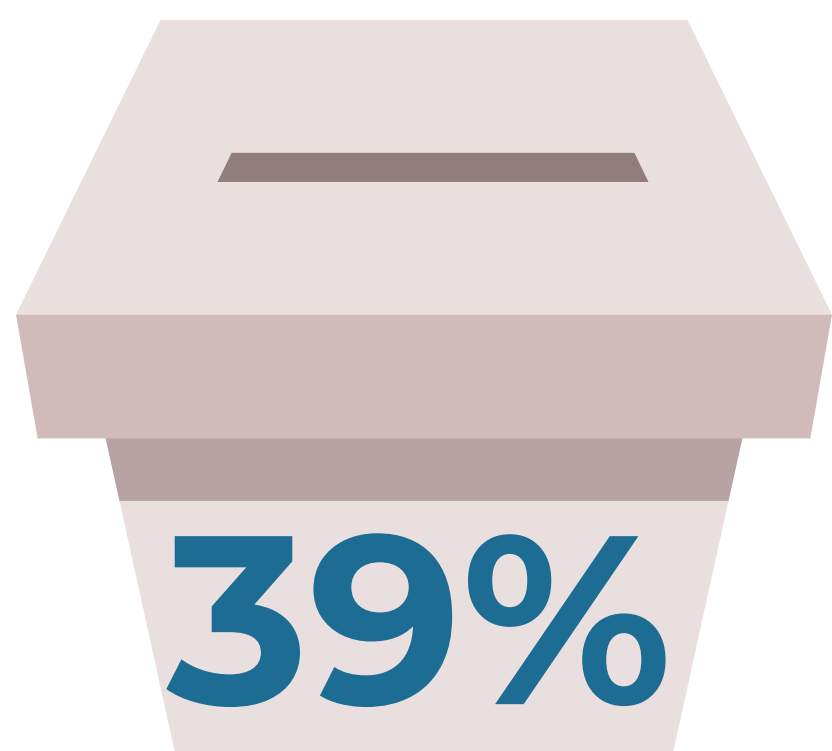

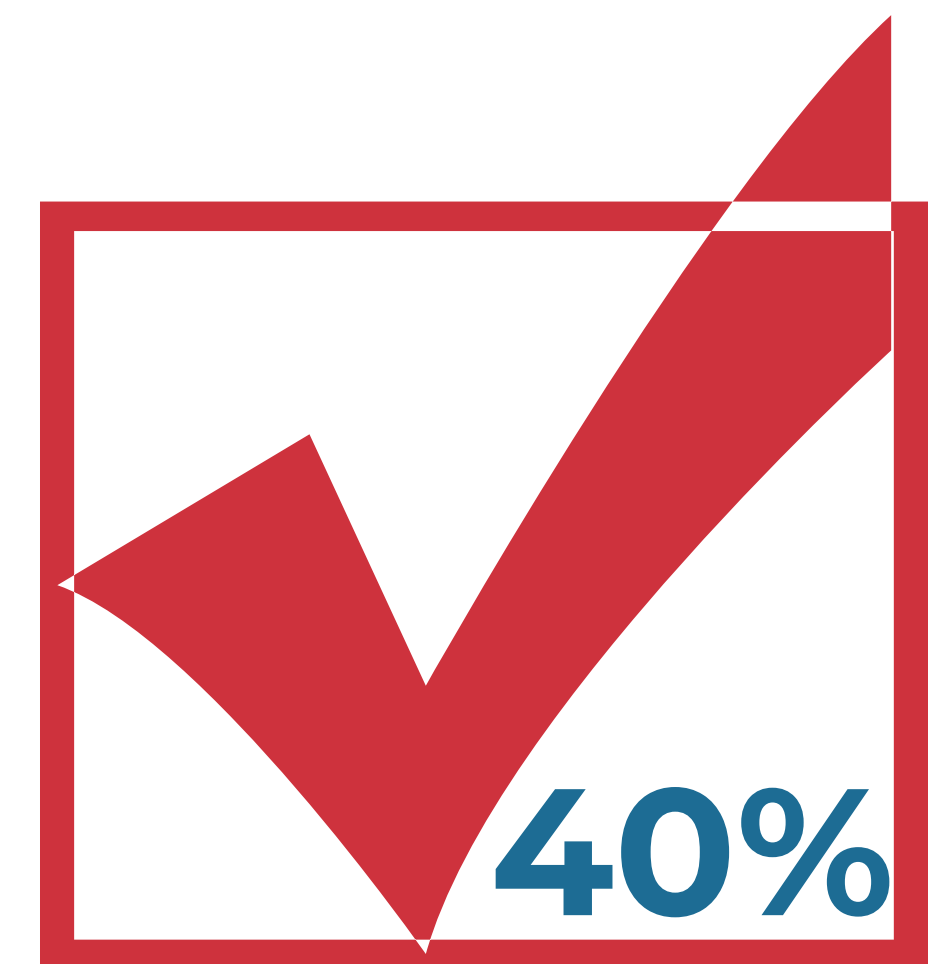

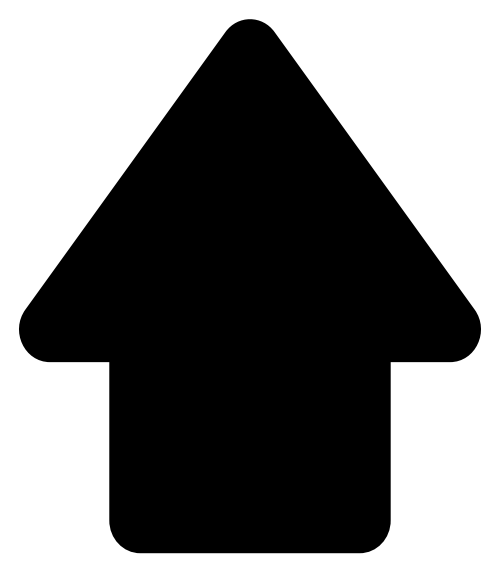

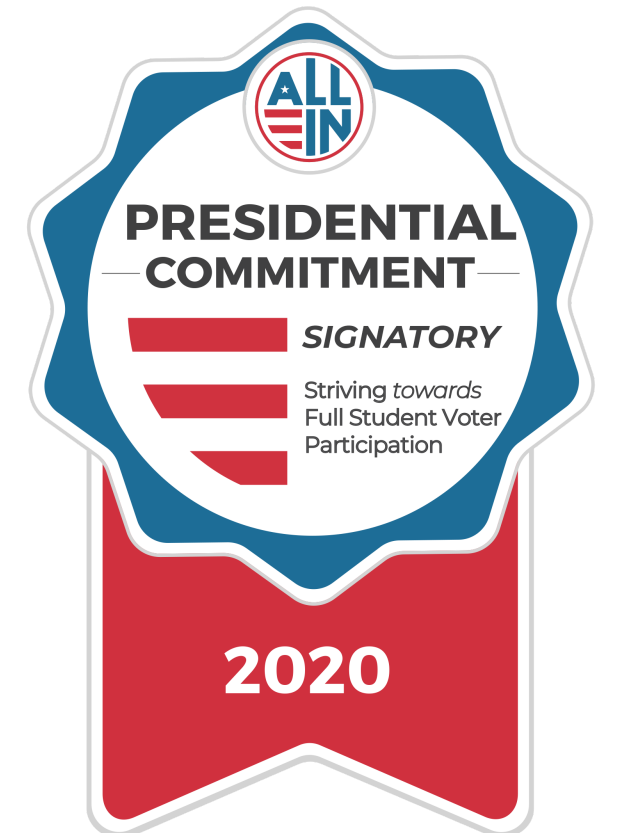
