

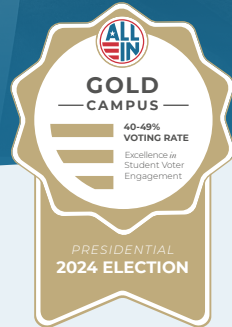

WHAT IS ALL IN?

The ALL IN Campus Democracy Challenge is a national, nonpartisan initiative that supports and recognizes colleges and universities working to strengthen civic learning, voter participation, and ongoing engagement in our democracy. ALL IN encourages institutions to help students form the habits of active and informed citizenship, as well as institutionalize civic engagement activities and programs - making them a defining feature of campus life.
