

2016 DEMOCRATIC ENGAGEMENT PLAN

September 27, 2016

August – Advocated with Maricopa County Elections Department to move a co-located precinct from an off-campus location to an on-campus location to better serve the needs of the 10,000+ students living on-campus. Was notified in late August that the polling location was approved.

August 12- Ed Pastor Center trained Undergraduate Student Government Staff on proper voter registration procedures and policies for the state of Arizona

August 13 & 14- Registered freshmen to vote at freshmen move in

September 19 & 20- Trained USG interns on how to register students to vote

September 20- Trained Community Assistants in the Barrett complex how to register their students to vote

September 21- Registered students to vote outside of the Memorial Union

September 26- Registered students vote at a residence hall debate watch party

September 27- National Voter Registration Day event where we registered students to vote, had a mock election with ballot initiatives, had all political student organizations tabling, free shirts, free food, educated student on upcoming dates. Included AZ Secretary of State and AZ Clean Elections Commission to help provide non-partisan voter information

September 28- Registering students to vote outside the Memorial Union.

October 1 – Nov 7- Adding a reminder on the ASU student portal "MyASU To-Do List" to have voter registration updated and information about the early polling and day-of polling location hosted on campus.

October 5- Registering students to vote outside the Memorial Union and having experts from both sides of Prop 205: Recreational Marijuana discussing the issue with students as the pass by.

October 13- We will be holding annual event "Sparking Democracy", where local political figures running for election will come and speaking with students about their platform.

October 17 through November 4- Hosting an Early Voting location on campus at PV West. Polling location open to all registered voters in Maricopa County, including community members, faculty, staff, and students.

November 2- Tabling at the Memorial Union telling students what identifications they will need at the polls in order to vote, and we will be telling them out the on campus Election Day polling location at the SDFC.

November 7- We will be outside the MU telling students what identifications they will need at the polls in order to vote, and we will be telling them out the on campus Election Day polling location at the SDFC.

November 8- We will have an on campus polling location at the SDFC. We will be directing students on where this location is located and what forms of identification they need when they get in line.
