Our action plan for the ALL IN Democracy Challenge is the following (many of these activities have already begun):

VOTER REGISTRATION:

- Students table at different events to register student voters campus-wide, now through October 11 when Indiana voter registration ends.
- Creation of a webpage to inform students about the details of voter registration
- Creation of a weblink button prominently displayed on students' Canvas course management system to remind them to register to vote; provides a link to access details of voter registration

NON-PARTISAN VOTER EDUCATION:

- A planned Election Series of events related to this year's election cycle with various speakers, presentations and panel discussions offered to all students
- Creation and dissemination of materials to inform students on candidate platforms and local issues in a balanced manner

VOTER TURNOUT:

- Walk 2 Vote (W2V) Celebration scheduled for October 12th; an event scheduled to bring students together to enjoy food, music, information and fun. At the close of the event, students will be led in a parade to "walk to election central" for early voting.
- "Walking Wednesdays" is a continuation of the W2V spirit where a campus-wide announcement invites students to meet at IU's Sample Gates, the main entranceway to campus, on Wednesdays at noon to walk together to the polling location on Oct. 19th, 26th and November 2nd during the period of early voting.
