### **MAYA PATEL** *Moderator*

Maya Patel is a senior at the University of Texas at Austin where she studies chemistry and public policy. She has served as the President of TX Votes and under her leadership TX Votes developed their in-class voter registration program, created their STEM committee, organized numerous events, and grew their Civic Engagement Alliance to over 110 student organizations. Her work has led to 18-25-year-olds being the largest bloc of registered voters in Travis County, UT's largest library serving as UT's second on-campus polling location, UT Austin receiving numerous national awards for their civic engagement programs, and a bill being filed in the Texas legislature to place polling locations on large college campuses. Maya also serves as the Chair of Campus Vote Project's Student Advisory Board and also recently started as the Texas State Coordinator. Maya is excited to continue her work across Texas and also as an MTV Leader for Change.

## PANELISTS



### JIM ACOSTA

Jim Acosta is CNN's Chief White House correspondent, currently covering the Trump administration. He previously covered the Obama administration. He regularly covers presidential press conferences, visits by heads of states, and issues impacting the Executive Branch of the federal government. In addition, Acosta reported from the 2016 campaign trail following then Republican presidential candidate Donald Trump. Before joining CNN in 2007, Acosta was a CBS News correspondent where he contributed primarily to the CBS Evening News. Prior to that, he was a correspondent for CBS Newspath, the network's 24-hour news service, and served as a reporter and/or substitute anchor for local television stations in Chicago, Dallas, and Knoxville, Tenn. He began his journalism career with WMAL-AM radio in Washington. Acosta graduated cum laude from James Madison University with a bachelor's degree in mass communications and a minor in political science.

### ROBERT SAMUELS

Robert Samuels is a political enterprise writer at The Washington Post. He travels the country to chronicle how issues, ideas and policies in the Washington bubble are playing out in the lives of real Americans. Samuels joined The Post in 2011 after spending nearly five years working at the Miami Herald. At the Herald, he covered politics, poverty, murder and mayhem. Samuels occasionally writes essays on race for The Post and is the newsroom's figure skating guru. Samuels grew up in the Bronx and is an alumnus of the Medill School of Journalism at Northwestern University, where he is the only student to have ever served as both editor in chief of the school newspaper, the Daily Northwestern, and its black student magazine.

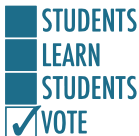
