### Commitment

The institution is committed to maintaining voter education and registration efforts to its campus community with the intent to increase participation across campus over the years to share in this civic responsibility.

### **Landscape**

This is an all commuter campus, with many low-income first-generation college students. Most students are nontraditional, with a variety of responsibilities outside of their education. The average age of our student body for the Fall 2023 semester is 24.1. Of the 12,157 students enrolled for the Fall 2023 term our students' race/ethnicity breakdown is as follows:

- a. White 7,216 (59.4%)
- b. Hispanic/Latinx 2,241 (18.4%)
- c. Black 1,234 (10.2%)
- d. Asian and Pacific Island 466 (3.8%)
- e. American Indian 67 (0.5%)
- f. Multi-race 448 (3.7%)

### Goals

Short-term Goals:

Our goal is to maintain student voter turnout by reaching 40% student voter turnout and to increase visibility of GRCC Votes and other civic minded student organizations on campus.

Long-term Goals:

Our long-term goal is to create a more unified approach as a college. We also hope to involve more students in leading this effort to increase peer to peer contact, to offer more leadership opportunities for students, and to introduce more employees to the work of GRCC Votes and informing students of voter information.

### <u>Strategy</u>

Our strategy focused on Voter Registration and Voter Education. Our leadership hosted many tables to engage with students on an individual level. These tables provided students with voter registration forms and information flyers, as well as swag such as buttons that students could make. We also created a LibGuide to provide accurate information to students. We also collaborated with members of the Student PIRGs for voter registration tabling events.

## **NSLVE**

Our campus was enrolled in NSLVE in the past, but we have not gotten access to previous reports. We have inquired multiple times to receive this information without findings.
