ALL IN 2018 Action Plan: GOAL = 50% Student Voter Rate

- I. **Enhance Voter Registration Information Available to Students**
 - a. HCC will enhance its webpage materials to include specific directions/deadlines for registering to vote online; through mail-in; and same day registration at the polls.
 - b. Web link will be sent to all faculty, staff, and student clubs and organizations.
- II. **Conduct Voter Registration and ALL IN Voting Pledge Drives:**
 - a. The Political Science Club SGA will conduct voter registration/ALL In Pledge to Vote drives.
 - b. COMM 101 courses are working on a campaign to increase student voter registration/voting rates.
 - c. SGA will work to get all student clubs/orgs to take the ALL IN Pledge to Vote.
 - d. Political Science Club and SGA will develop “toilet talk” flyers in restrooms around campus register and vote.
- III. **Provide Election/Candidate Information**
 - a. HCC will work with Illinois State University, Illinois Wesleyan University, the League of Women Voters, and WGLT (local NPR station) to host a variety of candidate Forums/Open Houses and encourage students to attend. Progress to date includes the following:

 - Oct. 10 - Illinois 105th House District - State Rep. Dan Brady, the Republican incumbent, and Democratic challenger Ben Webb - University Galleries at Illinois State University, 6:00 pm
 - Oct. 17 - Illinois 88th House District - State Rep. Keith Sommers, the Republican incumbent, and Democratic challenger Jill Blair - Alumni Center at Illinois State University, 6:00 pm
 - TBD Working on confirming Oct 22, 23 or 25: 18th Congressional District: U.S. Rep Darin LaHood, the Republican incumbent, and Democratic challenger Junius Rodriguez, 6:00 pm
