### NOMINATION PROCESS

#### ✓ Who to nominate

Only one student per ALL IN participating institution may be nominated. An institution may nominate any student who:

- was enrolled during the 2021-2022 academic year,
- has never before been honored by ALL IN, and who,
- supported nonpartisan voter registration, education, and turnout on campus.

#### ✓ How to nominate

The ALL IN primary contact at the institution must complete this [nomination form](#).

- Each institution may decide how to choose the student to nominate for the ALL IN Student Voting Honor Roll,
- Only one student per institution can be nominated,
- Please ensure the campus president or chancellor is aware of the nomination.

Information and materials that the nomination form requires, include:

- Institution's name,
- Student's name,
- Student's expected graduation year,
- Student's email address,
- Up to 250 words describing why the student is being nominated.

#### ✓ Timeline

- **April 1:** Nominations must be submitted to ALL IN. The nomination is embargoed.
- **April 25:** Nominees must complete the Nominee Form emailed to them by ALL IN
- **May 6:** Campuses receive communication & social media toolkit to announce the recipients. The recipient list is embargoed.
- **May 12:** 2022 ALL IN Student Voting Honor Roll recipients are announced publicly by institutions and posted on ALL IN's website.
