

Voting Ambassador

Overview: Voting Ambassadors will engage with their peers at Inver Hills Community College about voter registration, mechanics of voting, and reasons to participate in our democracy.

Duties:

- Complete training in non-partisan voter engagement and voter registration
- Table in campus buildings to register students to vote
- Staff voting and election-related campus events
- Give presentations about voting to classes (in person and on Zoom)
- Collaborate with Student Senate and attend Senate meetings if possible (every other Thursday, 3-4pm)

Hours per week: approximately 5 hours per week until Election Day (November 7, 2023). Approximate start date is September 12.

Wage: \$15/hour

Minimum Qualifications:

- Currently enrolled in a minimum of 6 credits at Inver Hills Community College
- Have a completed FAFSA on file and eligible for work study
- Punctual, reliable and accountable for your work schedule
- Ability and willingness to speak in large and small groups
- Interest in voting and democracy
- Ability to work on campus
