



### Urbana-Champaign Voter Action Plan

- 1) Facilitated meetings with various voter registration and GOTV groups, including Illinois Student Government, University YMCA, Chancellor's Office, Dean of Students, and Champaign County Voters Alliance.
- 2) TurboVote was acquired to assist with voter registration. The tool was launched late in the election season but is part of the strategy moving forward (supported by the BigTen grant)
- 3) Several groups tabled in high traffic areas across campus to register students to vote.
- 4) Updated Dean of Students Voter Information website: <https://go.illinois.edu/voter-registration> and displayed BigTen video on various electronic billboards on campus and on the jumbotron at a football game.
- 5) Illinois Student Government hosted the 2018 Illini Democrats and Illini Republicans Debate on October 2nd from 6:30pm-7:30pm in the Courtyard Cafe of the Illini Union.
- 6) Sent MassMail on October 16 to all students encouraging them to register to vote, providing information about voting and upcoming events on campus.
- 7) Illinois Student Government organized debate watch parties on October 18 for the Congressional race between incumbent Rodney Davis and challenger Betsy Dirksen Londrigan (supported by the BigTen grant).
- 8) Illinois Student Government and other student leaders hosted Pollapalooza, on October 26 from 11am-3pm, an event to raise awareness about the election and register voters. The event featured political campaigns, music and food (supported by the BigTen grant).
- 9) The Illinois Student Government hosted a Dialogue Series between the Illini Democrats, Illini Democratic Socialists, Illini Republicans, and Illini Libertarians on November 1 from 6:30pm-7:30pm in the Pine Lounge of the Illini Union.

10) Hosted early voting location in the Illini Union to make is easier for students to access a voting location. October 25 through October 26, October 27, October 29 through November 2, November 3-5.
