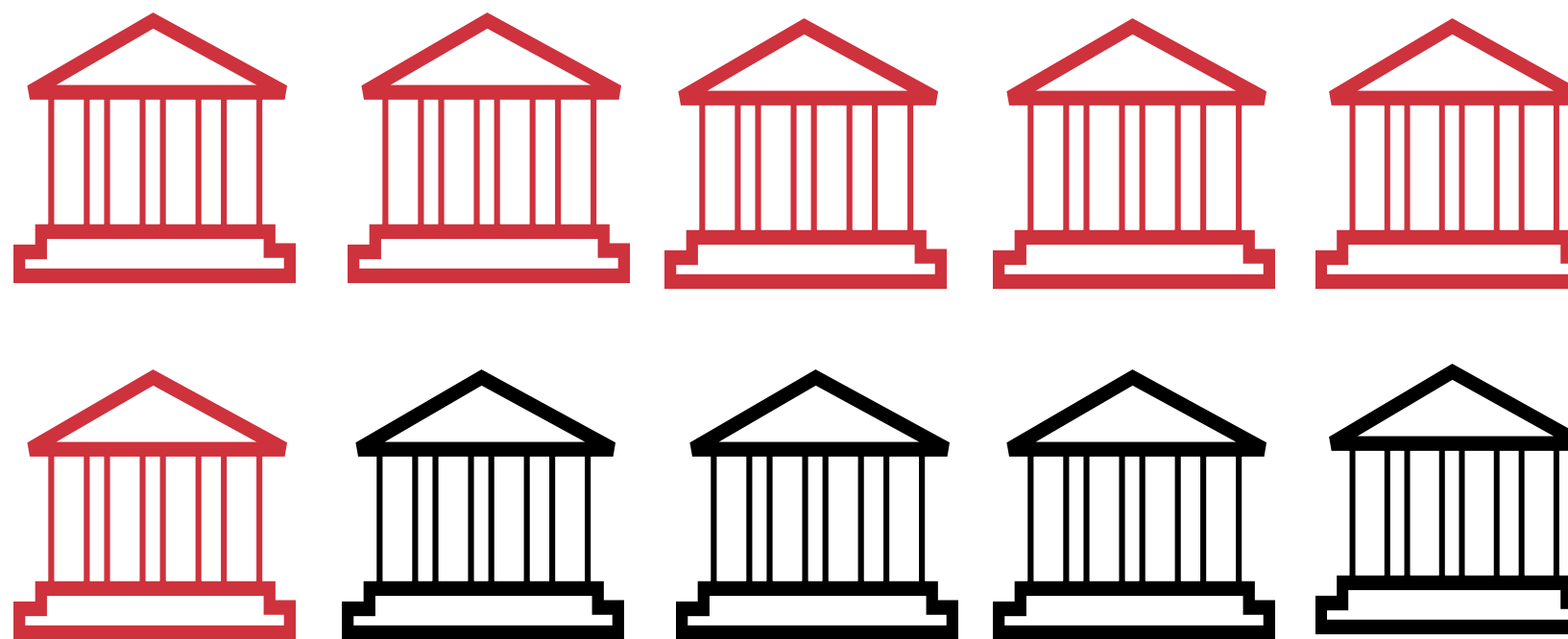
## Big Sky Voting Challenge Summary

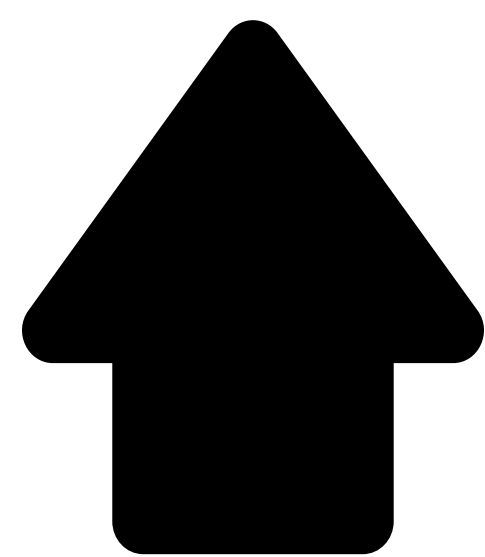
Average 2018 voter registration rate at ALL IN Big Sky campuses

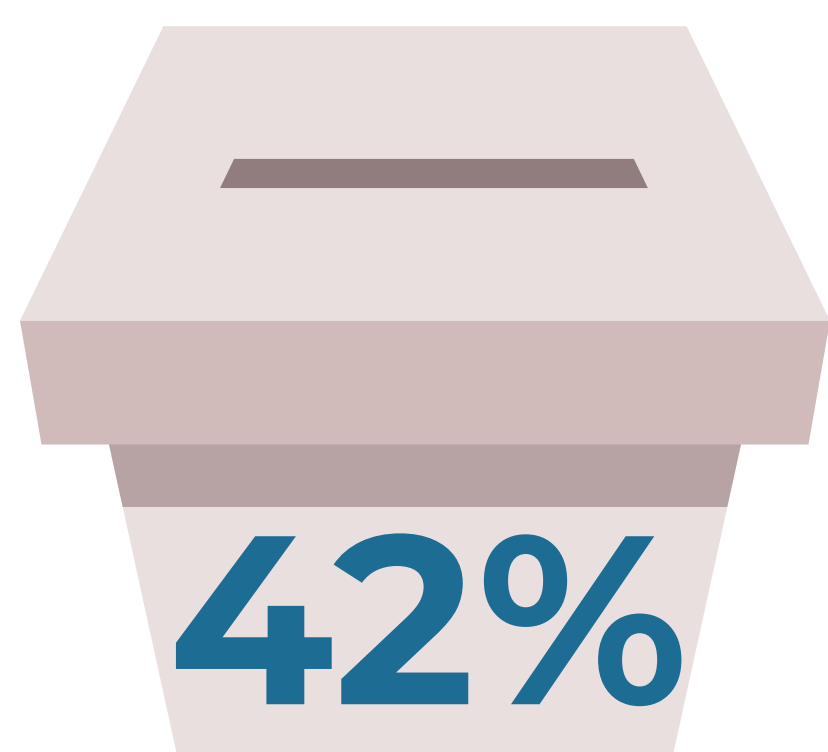

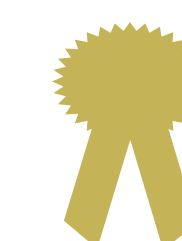
